
Education world is a plethora of Students & Innovative subjects. Learning journey in University gives immense opportunities to Students, nurture their life way forward.

Analysis: Table I shows the gender-wise analysis of the students for the last five years. In the year 2015-16, total students were 2127, out of which 478 are females and rest 1649 are males. In the year 2016-17, out of 2053 students, 453 were females and rest 1600 were males. In the year 2017-18, 445 out of 1976 (22.52%) were female students and rest 1531 students were male.

In the year 2018-19, out of total count i.e., 2415, 21% of the students were female (517) and rest 79% were males. In the year 2019-20, total students were 1879, out of which 340 (18% approx.) were females and remaining 1539 (82% approx..) were male.

From 2015 to 2017, growth of the female counts has been stagnant, on a contrary there has been a high growth on female counts in the year 2018-19. But in current scenario, there has been a reduction in female counts. So, corrective action plan needs to be drafted for further increasing the female counts.
