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Differently Abled (Divyangjan) Friendliness, Barrier Free facilities in the campus


Jagannath University aims to provide an inclusive education framework for all and so strives to create a barrier free and differently abled (divyangjan) friendly environment in our campus. Lifts, ramps, special toilets/bathrooms as well as specific facilities are provided all over the campus wherever required. A special reading hall for differently-able students, Braille books and assistive software (screen reading) and other equipment are available in the Knowledge Resource Centre. Scribes and additional time are provided at the time of examination as per norms. Divyangjan-friendly wheelchairs, vehicles and equipment are provided to employees/students as per their requirement.

Ramps Facility

he ramps were built in every building of the university for continence and safety of disabled persons (Divyangjan) shown in figure

Disabled friendly washrooms

Physical facility (wheelchair)

There is an availability of wheelchair for the disabled person and one assistant is also available for the movement of disabled person from one place to another as per their requirement. The physical facility has been shown in the figure








Human Assistance and Information Centre

A Procedure to be followed for providing an amanuensis to a candidate with temporary/permanent disability during examination days

An amanuensis may be provided to a candidate who meets with temporary / permanent disability during the days of examination and request for an amanuensis.

The following procedure should be adopted in this connection:

(a) The candidate who meets with an accident during the days of examination and requests for an amanuensis should normally meet the Controller of Examinations, at least 24 hours before the commencement of the examination, together with the following declarations:

Signature of the amanuensis with local address

- (a) The amanuensis should be a student of the standard lower than the exam for which he will act as amanuensis.
- (b) The examinee who meets with an accident should submit a medical certificate from the Principal Medical and Health Officer of the District or by a Medical
- (c) The same amanuensis should continue for all the examination days.
- (d) The candidate will have to pay an amount of Rs. 150,00 per paper to the University.
