The awareness should be generated among the public so that the complaint is addressed to the appropriate authority and the action can be taken faster.

Besides the regular activities of display of banners, posters, advertisements in the Newspapers and organization of activities such as lecture, panel discussions, competitions in Government and Public Sector Organizations, the Commission this year is reached out to college and school students in a big way. Debates/Elocution/Lectures have been organized in 135 cities/towns spread across the country. CVOs of 101 organizations are involved in these competitions and each CVO has been assigned certain number of cities/towns instructed to organized these competitions. Activities have been organized across India in cities including Delhi, Chennai, Mumbai, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Bangalore, Pune, Rajasthan and Ahmadabad.
