

The virtual workshop platform brought together entrepreneurs, student entrepreneurs, participants, mentors and mentors from the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India. The audience got connected through live link of the seminar on Jagannath University YouTube channel. Dedicated Zoom platforms links were used by the resource persons and participants who had pre-requested for direct interaction with the mentors.

Session Proceedings

The session commenced with a welcome address from President Jagannath University, Dr. Vaishali Sharma. She emphasized on the need to MSMEs are an important sector for the Indian economy and have contributed immensely to the country's socio-economic development. It not only generates employment opportunities but also works hand-in-hand towards the development of the nation's backward and rural areas.

The first session was about the "First step to start a new business, Govt. schemes & Support to new Enterprises." Mr. Pradaeep Ojha, Deputy Director, MSME-DI, Jaipur apprised the participants about the steps which need to be taken to build and sustain start-up ideas. He told the participants about Loans and grant programs offered directly to entrepreneurs; to stimulate business activity. He further said that India is witnessing a startup boom across all sectors including technology, innovation, health, robotics, automobiles, food, and education and so on. There are a total of 50,000 startups currently in India and as per the estimations, our country will add another 50,000 by 2024.

He informed the participants that Government of India is offering innumerable schemes to make the process easy for entrepreneurs and encourage budding entrepreneurs to kick-start innovative businesses that will eventually create employment opportunities. These schemes provide financial assistance to potential individuals and organizations in the form of subsidies and loans.

The second session was "How to execute your idea into a successful venture & related innovative marketing strategies". Mr. Akhilesh Trivedi, Global Mentor & Strategist interacted with students and guided them on suitable branding and marketing strategies for their respective strategies.

Mr. Madhukar Sharma, Assistant Director, MSME-DI, Jaipur took third session on "How to prepare a viable and loanable project report". He explained how participants can plan for




Figure 2: Participant Feedback
