Program Objective:

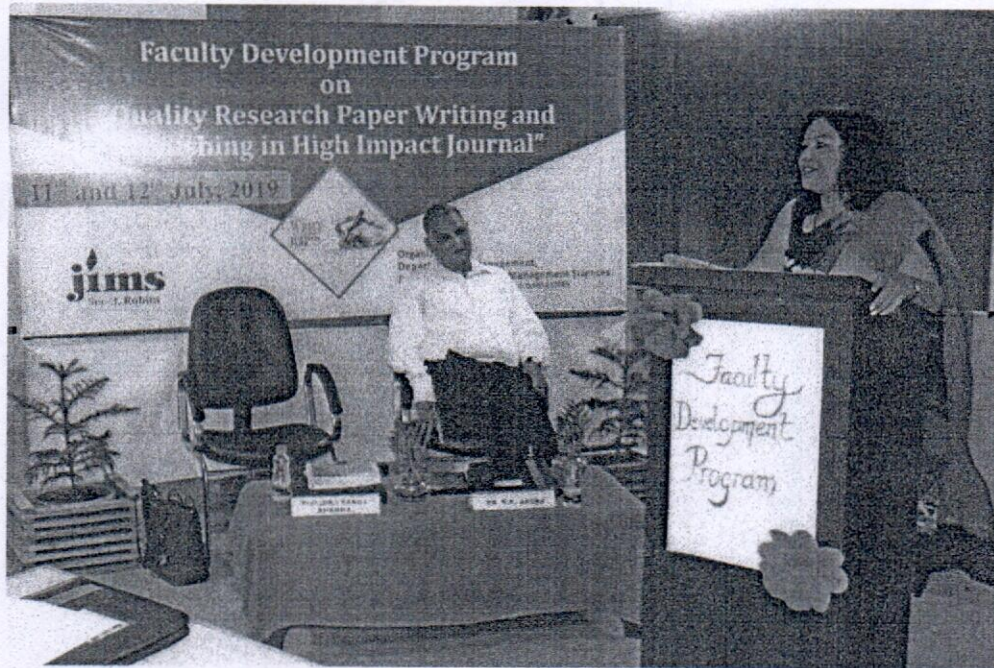
- Understanding the need and basic concept of research;

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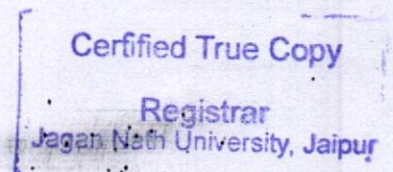


Afternoon Session (Day-1)

12/07/2019 Day-2 Forenoon Session

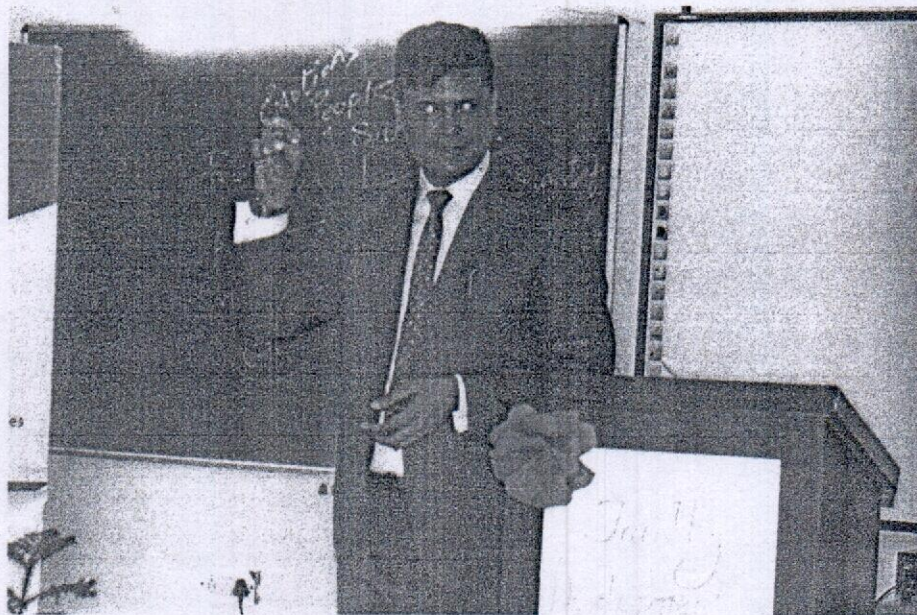
