

The speaker for the session was Prof Dr. Rajeev Sharma Former Principal, Seth Motilal Teacher Training College, Jhunjhunu.Dr. Sharma is a renowned academician who has delivered lectures at leading Universities of the country.

Speaker Credentials:

Dr. Sharma is the Former Principal, Seth Motilal Teacher Training College, Jhunjhunu. He has travelled across the country and has served various universities. He is a leading academician of the country and has delivered many acclaimed lectures at leading institutions of India.

Brief Proceedings of the FDP:

The FDP was organized by IQAC at Sitapura Campus between 10:30 am to 3:30 pm .The sessions were open to all academicians and research scholars. . The sessions witnessed over 100 participants.

The first day of the FDP initiated the audience to the need for classroom management. Dr. Sharma told the audience that the expectations of the students have evolved and it is important for the faculty members to offer a excellent classroom experience.

He advised the audience that it is important for a faculty to build rapport with the students based on trust and understanding, it is important for the faculty to let his/her compassion for each student reflect through nonverbal behavior and paraverbal communication. The second, third and fourth day of the FDP was spent on detailed discussion of tools and templates for effective classroom management.

He advised the following golden rules to manage the classroom effectively: Practice patience and Rational Detachment, Set effective limits, Set your schedule, Engage with students

He advised the audience to praise students for jobs well done, as doing so improves academic and behavioral performance. It also encourages students to repeat positive behavior. Praising the student use of specific tactics goes a long way in ensuring in motivating other students to do the same.

A final assessment was carried out for the audience. The registered participants was provided with certificate of participation. A feedback form was also circulated amongst the audience to assess view about the FDP. The participants ranked the FDP as "Excellent".



Introduction

Faculty of Law, Jagannath University in association with National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi organized a day long training programme on February 17, 2018. 160 participants including students', faculty members, advocates and NGOs representing different institutions participated in the programme. The programme was organized with an objective to sensitize University students', faculty members and common man on human rights issues.

Inaugural Ceremony





The inaugural programme commenced at 10.00 am with registrar of the University, Mr. Tanmay Pattanaik extending floral welcome to chief guest on the occasion, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Prakash Tatia, Chairman Rajasthan Human Rights Commission. On the occasion the dais was graced by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Professor (Dr.) V K Aggarwal, Registrar Tanmay Pattaniak and Dean of faculty of law. It was followed by traditional auspicious lamp lighting ceremony as a tribute to Mother Saraswati, the goddess of knowledge. It was then followed by a welcome speech and concept presentation by Professor (Dr). Govind Singh Rajpurohit, Dean Faculty of Law, the convener of the programme. He started his speech that the National Human Rights Commission from its inception on October 12th 1993 seriously looking into training and education of various segments of society towards human rights.

Educating university students is one of the prime responsibilities in this regard. According to Section 12(h) of protection of Human Rights Act 1993 – NHRC – India is mandated to spread Human Rights literacy among various sections of society and promote awareness of the safeguards available for the protection of these rights through publications, the media, seminars and other available means. In his speech he spoke about the training programme and how it focuses to sensitize University students' and faculty members on human rights issues. He also gave a brief about the sessions to be carried out during the training programme and a brief introduction about the experts for all session.

Presidential address by Vice Chancellor



Professor (Dr.) V K Agarwal is the Vice Chancellor of Jagannath University. He had been a Head & Dean faculty of Law, Kurukshetra University, and Haryana. He reflected on the journey of Human Rights discourse in India and around the

globe. His speech further emphasized the need to spread Human Rights education to neighborhood rather than keeping it a classroom discourse. Then he went on to dwelt upon the philosophy behind Human Rights which lies at Natural Law or Law in nature. "Natural law even in the absence of any statute talks about Human Rights", he said. In his insightful speech he explained that Indian Constitution in its part III and IV has incorporated articles from Universal Declaration of Human Rights and how Constitutional remedies enshrined under article 32 and 226 have helped remedied serious human rights violations. He elaborated upon *Rudal Shah* V. *State of Bihar* as to how this case has set a new paradigm around long illegal detentions in jail without an iota of trial. This was the watershed moment when Apex Court awarded compensation for illegal detention. Then he elaborated upon


national Human Rights Act, 1993, which institutionalized the concept of human rights formally by citing section 2 of the Act (life, liberty and dignity).

Second part of his presentation was an academic marvel wherein he explained the need to have Human Right Act, 1993 despite having Fundamental Rights in Constitution. On this his lecture was premised on the fact that that there were lacunas in the existing framework of proper implementation as it was seen as cumbersome, costly, vexatious and arcane. Human Rights Act is seen as more quick in providing remedy for violations. At length he tried to explain how Act, has worked efficiently as an investigating agency though its recommendations are not binding. He concluded his speech by stressing the need to have law in action rather merely keeping them dormant in the books.



Session Proceedings

Session 1: Introduction to Human Rights



shedding light on philosophy which
germinated the idea of Human Rights.
Then he dwelt upon the constitutional

provisions regarding Human Rights. He weaved a thread through the global and local framework of Human rights. First part of his presentation had the question put to enchanting audience. What if we did not have Constitutional provisions? Would human being not have Human Rights? Then he went on to explain the core conceptual framework around human rights which revolves around human rights i.e. a moment a human is born free, he is inherently endowed with human rights. He made an attempt to differentiate between human rights and legal rights. He emphasized to go beyond the simple textual framework of human rights and need to read it comprehensively in consonance with other social sciences.

Second part of his presentation revolves around human dignity. "Dignity is what stands us apart from animals", he said. "Human rights are not created by any statute rather they are there simply because we are humans. Judicial system or judicial administration is merely a mechanism to provide remedy for the violation", he concluded. At the end of his presentation he delivered a detailed lecture on specific Human Rights enumerated under various instruments i.e. U.N., UDHR. The whole presentation was insightful.

Session 2: Human Rights Institutions in India





Expert guest for second session was Professor N H Gupta, Former Head Faculty of Law, Rajasthan University. His presentation was based on Human Rights Institutions in India, their working their functions. His speech was

alighting as he introduced the concept of Human Rights as value based. His speech gave an insight into actual functioning of State Human Rights Commissions. These commissions, he emphasized, are not providing remedy rather identifying the diseases in human rights issues. The session proved to be effective with the use of case scenarios by the speaker to enhance the understanding of the participants. The session also proved to be effective, when expert threw light on specific provisions in global framework and their operative interpretation in India. In the end of the session he put forward certain valuable suggestion how to make human rights a reality in daily life and they could be integrated since childhood.

Session 3: Rights of other Vulnerable Groups



Justice J D Sharma, an eminent jurist was the guest of honour and expert on the occasion. He began his lecture by dwelling upon definition of Human and Humanity. During this session he introduced the notion of Vulnerable Groups and the changing

nature of these groups. In particular he focused on the issues of child labour, bonded labour system and the laws in placed to curb the malaise. He explained the difficult nature of the child adolescent labour prohibition and regulation Act 1986. At the same time he shed light on Civil Rights Act 1985. Later on his presentation was dedicated to Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC). Here the various

provisions and benefit of ratification of CRC was discussed. The session was informative and enriching.

Then he went on to speak about Rights of Women. With his vast experience as Jurist who has dealt with women issues by explaining the global conventions around Human Rights. At length he elaborated upon Convention on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women. He spoke about why we require CEDAW when we had the UDHR. The need for this convention was explained with many anecdotes of violence against women from his experiences as Judge. The speaker was excellent in bringing out various forms of violence and how to tackle them using the CEDAW convention rights.

Session 4: Rights of Women and Children



Professor G S Karkara, former Head & Dean, Department of Law, Rajasthan University was the expert guest in session 4. His presentation was on a pressing issue which has captured the attention of civil society, media and academia: Abortions of Female fetus

which is popularly known as Female Feticide. As state has tried to prevent this menace from happening by enacting a statute law known as Female Feticide and Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal diagnostic techniques (Prohibition of sex selection Act 2003), the core of expert's presentation was around this pioneering Act of Legislature. He started off with the position of women in Vedic period where semblance of equality between man and women had in every walk of life. Then he switched over to medieval period when position of women started taking a different trajectory and become worse. The situation remained constant for centuries to come and owing to dowry system the neglect of women was complete as result young female child were killed after birth. He described the situation in post independent

India as not rosy but nonetheless government of the day put in hard efforts to stop the killing of girl child and made necessary legislative efforts to stop this menace. Through power point presentation he tried to explain the provisions of the Act in a lucid manner. In the end he exerted everyone present in the hall to spread the message of save the girl child so the skewed sex ratio could be checked and have healthy society.
