The second, third and fourth day of the FDP comprised of a detailed overview of on the steps to create blended learning program including objectives, self-paced learning and assessments.

The speaker enlightened the audience that Blended learning can be applied to a range of situations, like academia. However the same might not work for corporate training. She therefore advised the audience to incorporate LMS and Gamification for corporate training. She told the audience to incorporate webinar tools like Zoom, MS Teams, Go To Meeting or Webex, which allow to schedule and manage webinar sessions within the LMS. She advised the audience that a first-class LMS should provide additional integration features such as auto or self-enrolling registration, real-time polling, virtual breakout rooms and attention monitoring tools, making implementing a blended learning model easy. She advised the audience that the webinar sessions could be reused for on-demand videos within courses, or as dedicated video content for training.

A final assessment was carried out for the audience. The registered participants was provided with certificate of participation. A feedback form was also circulated amongst the audience to assess view about the FDP. The participants ranked the FDP as great learning experience.

- Research proposals are a quintessential guide for the execution of any research project
- Submission of well-writing research proposals are required for a Master's dissertation as well as when applying for an MPhil/PhD program.
- The APA ethics code mandates that researchers have an accurate and detailed research proposal before undertaking any research activity.
- Research proposals help to concretize ideas anticipate any pitfalls that may arise in the project.
- An effective grant proposal increases the likelihood of getting funding for your research projects.

Keeping above points in mind, Faculty of Management, Jagan Nath University organized a One Day Workshop for University teachers, research scholars, & students with the prime objective of developing research proposal writing skills. The workshop was successfully organized on 15.01.2019 in the Auditorium of Sitapura Campus.
