#### **Brief Introduction of the Speaker:**

The speaker for the session was Dr. Vinita Agarwal, Professor, Amity University, Jaipur. Dr. Agarwal is a renowned academician who has delivered lectures at leading Universities of the country.

#### **Speaker Credentials:**

Dr. Agarwal has been serving as a professor at Amity University, Jaipur. She has travelled across the country and has served various universities. She is an expert of technology tools and has delivered many acclaimed lectures at leading institutions of India.

#### **Brief Proceedings of the FDP:**

The FDP was organized by IQAC at Seminar Hall between 10:30 am to 3:30 pm . The sessions were open to all academicians and research scholars. . The sessions witnessed over 50 participants.

The first day of the FDP initiated the audience to the concept of blended learning process. Dr. Agarwal. defined blended learning as an approach to education that combines online educational materials and opportunities for interaction online with traditional place-based classroom methods. She enlightened the audience on the types of blended learning.

The second, third and fourth day of the FDP comprised of a detailed overview of on the steps to create blended learning program including objectives, self-paced learning and assessments.

The speaker enlightened the audience that Blended learning can be applied to a range of situations, like academia. However the same might not work for corporate training. She therefore advised the audience to incorporate LMS and Gamification for corporate training. She told the audience to incorporate webinar tools like Zoom, MS Teams, Go To Meeting or Webex, which allow to schedule and manage webinar sessions within the LMS. She advised the audience that a first-class LMS should provide additional integration features such as auto or self-enrolling registration, real-time polling, virtual breakout rooms and attention monitoring tools, making implementing a blended learning model easy. She advised the audience that the webinar sessions could be reused for on-demand videos within courses, or as dedicated video content for training.

A final assessment was carried out for the audience. The registered participants was provided with certificate of participation. A feedback form was also circulated amongst the audience to assess view about the FDP. The participants ranked the FDP as great learning experience.

- An effective grant proposal increases the likelihood of getting funding for your research projects.
