ABOUT THE THEME

Jagan Nath University, Jaipur being a member of United Nations Academic Impact (UNAI) has identified the theme in alignment with UNAI theme related to one of the SDGs.

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the Global Goals, were adopted by all the member states of United Nations in 2015, as a "Universal Call" for action to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that all people enjoy peace and prosperity by 2030. India, as a prominent developing country, has played an important role in shaping the SDGs. As such, India has been effectively committed to achieving the SDGs even

before they were fully finalized. The SDG India Index 2020–21 is more robust than the previous editions on account of wider coverage of targets and indicators. The 17 SDGs are integrated in national development plan in a way that development must balance social, economic and environmental sustainability.

The UNAI has selected Goal 13, Climate Action as the SDG for the month of November. Weather patterns are changing, sea levels are rising, and weather events are becoming extreme. Although greenhouse gas emissions are projected to drop about 6 percent in 2020 due to travel bans and economic slowdowns resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, this improvement is only temporary. Climate change is not on pause. Once the global economy begins to recover from the pandemic, emissions are expected to return to higher levels. Saving lives and livelihoods requires urgent action to address both the pandemic and the climate emergency.

This paper presentation competition looks forward to deliberate upon mechanisms to combat climate change. As stated by our Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, India is giving great priority evolving our understanding of the social, economic, and environmental linkages that define quality lives for the people. This platform will help to understand and develop current and new frameworks and assess their relevance for the agenda.

PAPER GUIDELINES

A. Paper submission –

The participants should mail their full papers with names of participants, programme, branch name (if required) and title of the paper and submit the hard copy of paper with abovementioned details at the registration desk, before the commencement of the event.

Format for paper:

1. Title of the paper
2. Abstract: each paper must be followed by an abstract of not more than 500 words. The abstract should contain name of the participants, e-mail address, branch name and field of paper.
3. Full Paper: approximately 2500 words on A-4 size paper.
4. Full text space arrangements: 1.5 line spacing
5. Font size: Title – 16 (Times New Roman/ Arial), Sub Title - 14(Times New Roman/ Arial), Text - 12(Times New Roman/ Arial)

Please Note : References/bibliography is to be made in APA format only. **B. Paper Presentation – Guidelines:**

Participants are required to submit the presentation of paper with names of participants, programme, branch name (if required) and title of the paper at the registration desk, half an hour before the commencement of the event.

Presentation format :

1. Introductory abstract followed by the main presentation.
2. The time allowed for presentation is 12 minutes and 3 minutes for question-answer session.
3. The presentation should be in MS power point 2003/2007 only.
